The MLSA invites applications for the 2018 Cyril Keogh Academic Bursary. Each year the MLSA awards award up to twelve bursaries to members for post-graduate study as follows:

Category One: Ten bursaries of €500

For MLSA members who complete a post-graduate course at National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ) level 9 or higher in a field of Medical Laboratory Science. The course may be fulltime or part-time.

Category Two: Two bursaries of €500

For MLSA members who complete a post-graduate course at National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ) level 9 or higher in the one of the following fields: Industrial Relations, Management, Occupational Health and Safety, Quality Management or Information Technology. The course may be fulltime or part-time.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Awards will be made retrospectively after successful completion of the course of study. Official documentation of successful completion of the course must be submitted with the application, i.e. copy of diploma or degree awarded.
2. Applications will be accepted for courses completed in the calendar year prior to the draw, therefore the 2018 awards will be made for courses completed in the calendar year 2017.
3. The closing for applications in 2018 is Friday 2nd March.
4. Applications must be made on this MLSA bursary application form, available on the MLSA website. Completed applications, to include all necessary supporting documentation, should be marked "Cyril Keogh Memorial Bursary Fund" and returned to MLSA Head Office, 4th Floor, Liberty Hall, Dublin 1 to arrive by 5pm on the closing date.
5. Applications / supporting documentation received after the closing date will not be accepted.
6. The decision of the Executive Committee in all matters relating to the fund is final.
7. Applicants must have been a member of the MLSA, with subscriptions fully paid and up to date, for at least one year immediately prior to the closing date for applications.
8. Bursaries will be awarded by lot at a draw to take place annually at the AGM of the MLSA.
9. Only one application per member per year will be accepted. Multiple applications will disqualify.
10. A maximum of one bursary will be awarded to a member in a five-year period.
11. Successful applicants will be paid by cheque.
12. The results of bursaries granted shall be published on the MLSA website and on MLSA social media channels.
13. The Executive Committee reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions as necessary at any time, including the quantity and financial value of the bursaries awarded.
